



## Steps to Complete RFHS Online Forms

1. You will need to login to Skyward Family Access in order to complete two separate forms in regards to RFHS Return to School Plan. If you do not remember your login or password please call 815-625-3886.
2. Once you login you will see a message about online forms being available. Please select the link that says fill out the online form. If you have multiple students at RFHS you will need to fill this form out multiple times.



3. There will be two learning options for you to choose from please select yes or no in each drop down box in order to submit the form. Please answer the bus question if it applies to you.

You will need to complete this form for all students in your household.

Tech Fee 2020-2021 School Year - \$0.00

Lost, stolen device, or damages beyond repair (actual cost) - \$300.00

Lost or damaged (non-functional) charger - \$35.00
